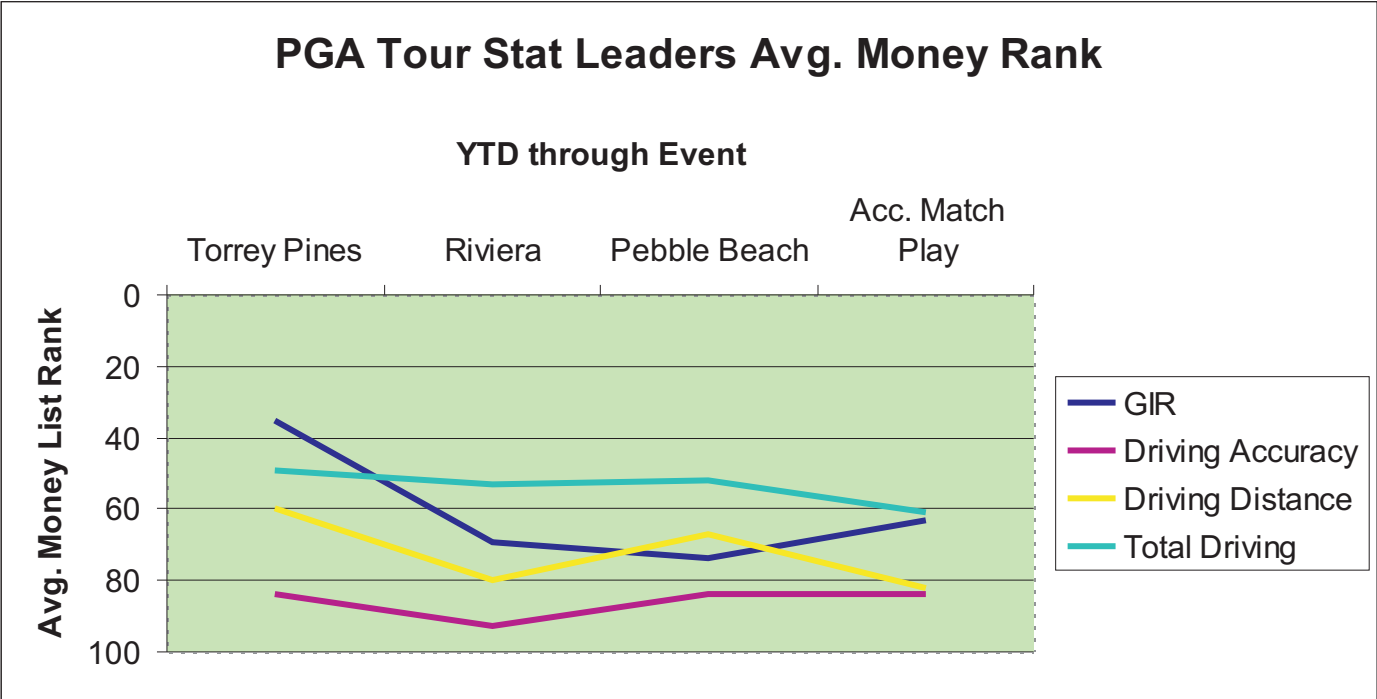

Driving Distance is shaping up to be one of the more volatile stats we’re tracking. After a big up week last week, it slips back to about last year’s value...down about 15 spots from last week. Total Driving also experienced a back slide from last week, down about 9 spots. The net numbers for Total Driving are way up from last year, but the Avg. Money List Rank is down. Not sure what that means at the moment.



The numbers are starting to paint an interesting picture here. At the moment, it looks like GIR% and Total Driving are worth about the same amount of cash. And similarly, so are Driving Distance and Driving Accuracy. How this speaks to the effectiveness of the Groove Rule, I don't know at the moment. But a few more data points should start to provide some clarity.
