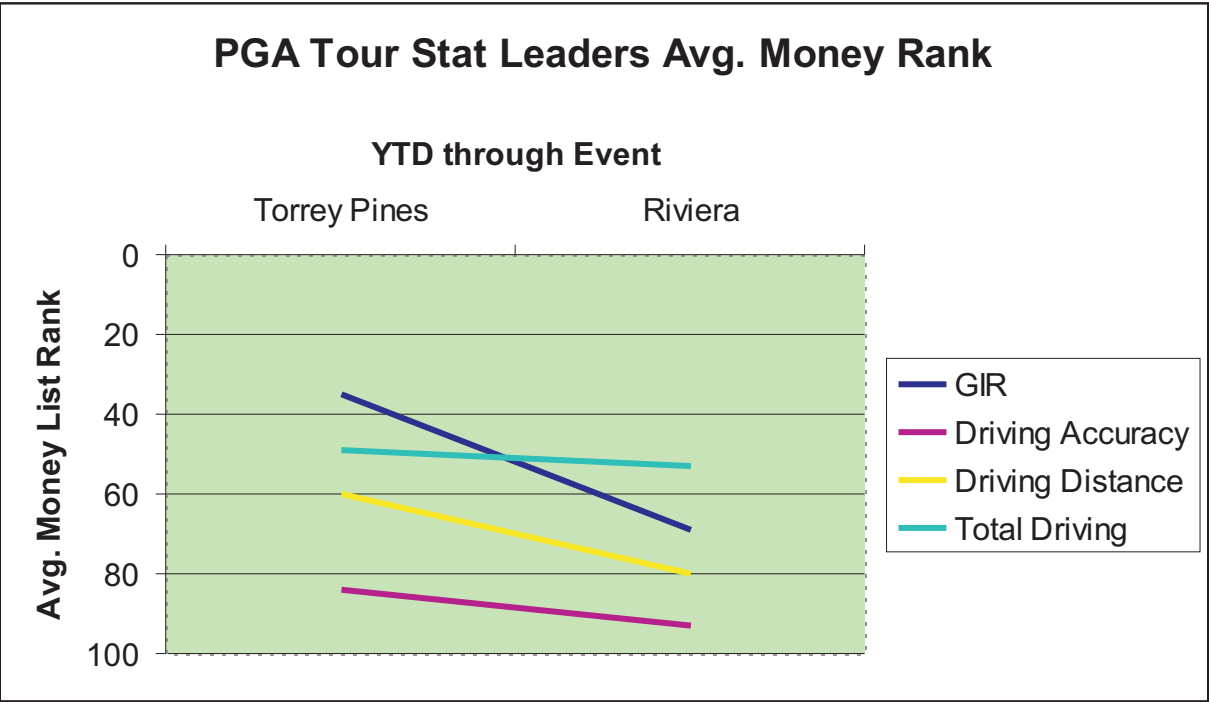

The long hitters numbers are already very close to last year. Pure distance appears to be landing at about the same spot on the money list as last year. Total Driving, which is long and straight combined looks to have slipped a few notches on the money list. But again, it's early.



GIR% leaders held the highest average position on the money list through Torrey Pines. That changed after last week when the Total Driving leaders blew by them for highest average rank. This chart might be interesting as the season progresses.
