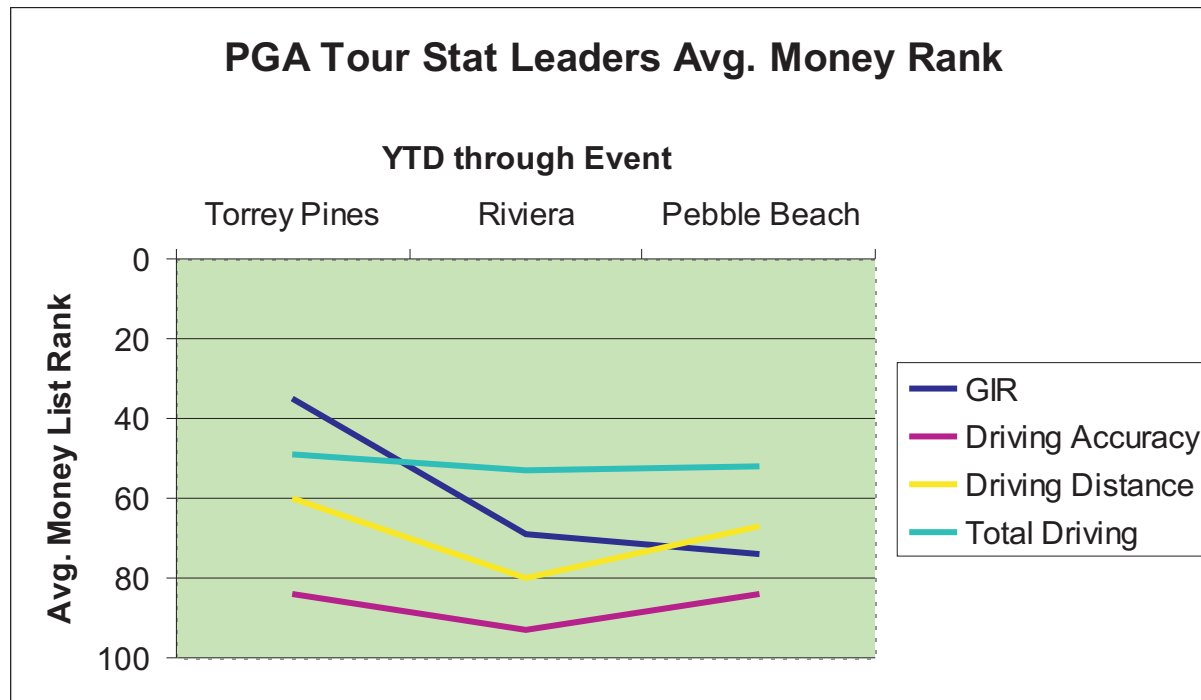

Pebble was a good week for the long hitters, with several finishing in the top 20 including the winner. The pure distance numbers are down, but I think that’s just because of the wet weather on the West Coast Swing. Way too early to call, but these stats make me wonder if the new, higher spin ball formulations may be having an impact on the numbers. Driving Distance average money rank is up significantly, while Total Driving is down 10 spots on the Money List. If the Groove Rule is working shouldn’t that be the other way around?



GIR% leaders dipped again this week, falling below Driving Distance leaders in average Money List rank. The upcoming week should be interesting as we have a split field competing in two events. Should get some movement in a couple stat categories.
